Before putting your pet under anesthesia, a veterinarian will perform a physical exam to identify any existing medical conditions that could complicate the procedure. Because there is always the possibility that a physical exam alone will not identify all of your pet's health problems, we suggest that a blood profile be performed prior to the procedure.

(We require this procedure for pets over the age of 7)

It is important to understand that a blood profile does not guarantee the absence of complications.
